Dr Mark Brundrett is an Adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Western Australia and a Research Associate of the West Australian Herbarium. For the past seven years, research has focussed on restoration of banksia woodland and the impacts of fire and weeds on Perth's urban bushland. He has many years of experience investigated interactions between plants and mycorrhizal fungi in natural and disturbed ecosystems. Other current research concerns the evolution of plant nutrition traits and biodiversity patterns in Australia. He also studies the conservation and diversity of orchids and has published a field guide for them.
